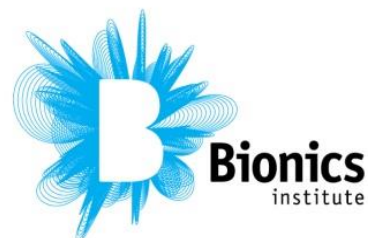


Needed urgently: babies
aged 2-12 months!



Call for Research Participants

Are you the parent or guardian of a child
between the ages of 2 months and 5 years?

We are seeking children in this age group, **with no known hearing loss**, to participate in a research project that aims to improve the early language development in children born with a hearing loss.



We are using a new child-friendly optical imaging technique to study how the brain in a child responds to sounds and how it develops over time to support language development. The imaging system (see picture) consists of a cap that has little light sources and detectors, which the child wears while listening to sounds, and watching a video or ideally sleeping. The imaging device is non-invasive and safe.

As a participant, you and your child would attend the Bionics Institute (384 Albert St, East Melbourne) for one to three imaging sessions of about 2 hours duration. Your travel expenses to the Bionics Institute will be reimbursed.
