RECRUITING FOR RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS

Are you the parent or guardian of a baby younger than 12 months of age?

We are seeking infants in this age group, with **NO KNOWN HEARING LOSS**, to participate in a research project that aims to improve the early language development in children born with a hearing loss.

What is Involved?

We are using a new child-friendly optical imaging technique to study how the brain in a child responds to sounds and how it develops over time to support language development.

The imaging system (see picture) consists of a cap that has little light sources and detectors, which the child wears while listening to sounds or watching a video.

The research session is 1-2 hours.
